◆ YIS VISION

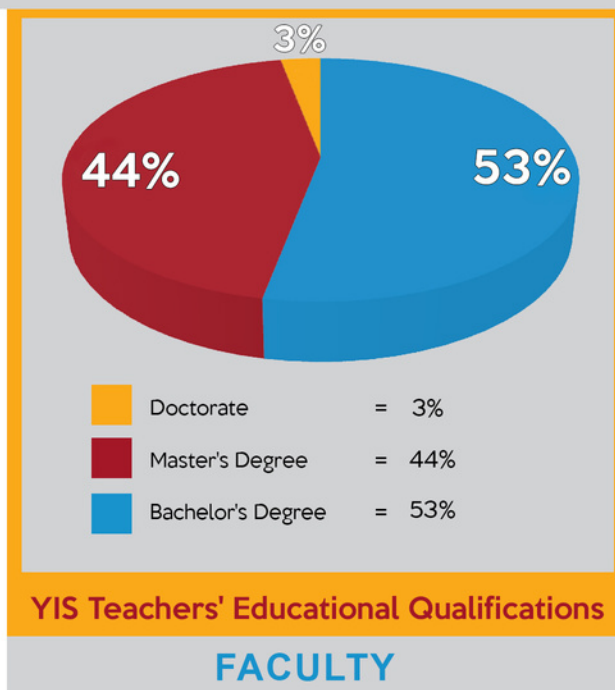
YIS prepares students for higher levels of learning and to be responsible global citizens.

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IB Diploma Programme Courses Offered at YIS

To be eligible for the IB Diploma, each student is required to complete **six IB courses**, with one subject taken from each group in the curriculum model:

- **Group 1: Studies in Language & Literature**
 - Language A (Language & Literature): English (HL/SL)
 - Language A (Literature): Burmese A Literature SSST (SL)
- **Group 2: Language acquisition**
 - Spanish ab initio - SL
 - Mandarin ab initio - SL
- **Group 3: Individuals and Societies**
 - Economics (HL/SL)
 - Psychology (HL/SL)
- **Group 4: Sciences**
 - Physics (HL/SL)
 - Chemistry (HL/SL)
 - Biology (HL/SL)
- **Group 5: Mathematics**
 - Mathematics - Analysis & Approaches (HL/SL)
 - Mathematics - Applications & Interpretation (HL/SL)
- **Group 6: Arts OR One subject from groups 1-4**
 - Visual Arts (HL/SL)

Further, all IB Diploma students must choose and complete:

- Three courses at **higher level (HL)**
- Three courses at **standard level (SL)**
- A course in the **Theory of Knowledge (TOK)**
- A 4,000- word **Extended Essay** in a subject of their choice
- **Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS)** programme

- Credit is given on a semester basis. One year of credit is equal to a full year course.
- Students are required to complete a minimum of 26 credits to graduate.
- Transfer students take a prorated number of credits.
- Languages must be consecutive levels of the same language.
- Myanmar Studies is waived for foreign students. They must take an additional elective course.
